

SUMMER 2009 DETOURS UW-MADISON CAMPUS



1. Observatory Drive will be closed in both directions between Bascom Hill and Park Street from move out to move in. Lot 9 will be closed but Lot 11 will remain open. Traffic should not turn into Observatory Drive from Charter Street unless it is going to Lot 11. Turning around on the short section of Observatory Drive that is open will be very difficult.

2. Charter Street between Linden Drive and University Avenue will be restricted to one-way southbound traffic only from move out to mid-June.

3. Babcock Drive will be gravel-paved but should be open from mid-July to September. Traffic can exit Lot 40 (behind Babcock Hall) onto northbound Babcock Drive.

4. Randall Avenue will be closed at University Avenue in both directions between May 20 and June 4. It will be closed in both directions at Campus Drive for one week starting May 28. Neither University Avenue nor Campus Drive will be impeded.

5. Charter Street will be closed in both directions at University Avenue between June 10 and June 19. The entrance to Physical Plant and Lot 22 will be open.

West Campus: The Campus Drive Reconstruction project starts May 18 and traffic will be limited to one lane each way. Other traffic restrictions include:

- Farley Avenue will be limited to northbound traffic only during the weekend of May 29.
- The eastbound off-ramp from University Avenue to old University Avenue will be closed June 1-5.
- The on and off-ramps from Campus Drive to Highland Avenue will be closed one at a time for about a week at the end of June.

All of these dates are subject to change due to weather and construction issues. Stay alert for more information about the dates of these detours as they become available.
