Interpreting your Google Books Search Results

- [Book Overview](#) – provides citation information (complete title, ISBN and subject headings), reviews, popular passages, places mentioned in the book, etc.
- [Viewing Options](#)
 - [Preview](#) – view a limited number of pages (access is determined by publisher). Usually the table of contents and/or index are included; sometimes several chapters are available.
 - [No Preview](#) – view basic citation information about the book
 - [Snippet View](#) – view a few sentences around your search term
